Description

A James Powell & Sons threaded glass footed bowl, pat. no. 7170, the bowl's undulating surface decorated with evenly spaced delicate horizontal threads on a flint and blue ground, designed by William Butler.

In 1834, James Powell, a wine merchant and entrepreneur, acquired the Whitefriars glassworks. He and his sons quickly became pioneers, developing new techniques and securing lucrative patents.
